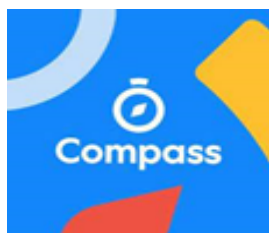
## Refunds

### COMPASS PAYMENTS CENTRE – Payment by Instalments

By agreeing to pay by instalments, Compass will charge your credit card the following percentage.

#### **5 Curriculum Contribution Instalments**

5 X 20% of Total (\$178) on the 15<sup>th</sup> each month commencing 15/12/2024

#### **10 Curriculum Contribution Instalments**

10 X 10% of Total (\$89) on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month commencing 15/12/2024

#### **Per Term Curriculum Contribution Instalments**

4 X 25% of Total (\$222.50) on the first day of term, except term 1, which will be debited on 15/12/2024
