



## Uniform

### Correct Uniform

You are expected to be neat and clean at all times and to wear your uniform correctly. Summer uniform must be worn by all students in Term 1. Either summer or winter uniform may be worn in April and May. All students **must** wear full winter uniform by 1st June until the end of August. Either summer or winter uniform may be worn in September and October and full summer uniform is to be worn from November 1st until the end of the year. **The blazer is a compulsory item and must be worn to and from school each day, on excursions and to all college assemblies, except in extreme heat when students may just wear their summer uniform. Blazers are to be taken to the final lesson of each day. The sports jacket and rugby top must NOT be worn with summer or winter uniform.** Non-uniform items may be confiscated. Students can purchase a plain navy rain jacket to wear over their uniform on wet days. This can be worn to and from school, but not inside the building.

### Casual Clothes Days

It is expected that students will be suitably and appropriately dressed on out of uniform days.

\* Thongs are a health and safety risk at school and must not be worn on Casual Dress Days.

### Physical Education

You must be correctly dressed for **Physical Education and Sport. Students inappropriately attired may be excluded from participation in school teams.** The College recognises the importance of the 'sun smart' message which is reinforced through health, physical education and sport lessons. **Sun screen** and **hats** are expected to be worn in P.E. and Sport lessons, particularly in **Terms 1 and 4 and for lunchtime sport.** Students are also advised to wear their sports hat in the grounds at recess and lunchtime in Terms 1 and 4. On interschool sport days, students must come to school in uniform and change before and after sport. This includes interschool sport try out and training sessions. The only exceptions occur when the team is going out of the College all day and students who have Physical Education or Sport Period 4 may wear their complete sport uniform home at the end of the day. Year 7 & 8 Students are allowed to wear their full PE uniform on days where they have scheduled PE classes. All other year levels must bring their PE uniform to get changed into when they have scheduled PE classes.

### Uniform For Excursions

**Only students wearing correct uniform will be allowed to attend excursions.** (An exception will only be made if your Student Manager receives a letter from a doctor stating that you are unable to wear a particular item.) All students are expected to wear their blazers on all excursions unless otherwise stated on the "Compass Event" information.

### Shoes

All students must wear black, leather, low heeled, lace-up school shoes. T-Bars are NOT permitted.

### School Bag

All students are expected to purchase the MGSC school bag, which is designed to prevent back injury, when used properly. Handbags/other bags are not accepted and may be confiscated.

### Music

The Music uniform is a requirement for public performances.

### Make-up and Jewellery

Make-up, coloured nail polish, jewellery, facial piercings other than those listed and extreme hair colours are not acceptable accompaniments to the College Uniform. Studs/small sleepers in pierced ears, small/clear nose studs and watches are accepted. For health and safety reasons, it is recommended that long hair be tied back.

Nails are to be kept short with the only exception the week before and after a verifiable school formal event. At all other times nails must be short and of a neutral colour.

### Out of Uniform Pass

**If you are unable to wear any part of your uniform** at any time, you need to bring a **note** from home. The note should be presented to your Student Manager at the **beginning of the day.** An out-of-uniform pass will be issued and is only valid for the time specified by the Student Manager. If you come out of uniform your Student Manager may be able to lend you a standard piece for the day. Students who are out of uniform may be excluded from attending classes and/or given an environmental duty consequence.
